

RULES GOVERNING THE ACCOMMODATION OF GUESTS WITH DOGS IN THE ABAT MARCET MONASTIC CELLS

- It is mandatory to report the presence of the pet upon arrival at the cell.
- One (1) dog per cell is allowed, subject to a fee per stay, plus a deposit as a guarantee against possible damage.
- The owner is responsible for their pet, its behaviour, and any damage it may cause to third parties, the property, or the furniture.
- A copy of the mandatory liability insurance policy must be provided.
- Every registered dog will wear a tag attached to its leash, which will be provided upon entry.
- Dogs are not allowed in the Abat Cisneros Hotel, the Abat Oliba Hostel, or in the other indoor areas of Montserrat (except guide or therapy dogs).
- It is essential to always keep your pet on a leash outside the monastic cell; potentially dangerous breeds must also wear a muzzle.
- The owner must keep the dog in proper hygienic and sanitary conditions.
- It is mandatory to collect the dog's droppings and dispose of them in the appropriate bins.
- The dog cannot be left alone in the cell at any time.
- Dogs are not allowed on the beds.
- It is not permitted to bathe the dog in the showers or to use the cell towels to dry it.
- It is not permitted to give food or water to the dog using utensils from the cell.
- Upon departure, the tag provided at check-in must be returned. Failure to do so will result in a fee deducted from the deposit.
- The deposit will be returned within a maximum of 4 days after departure, once the proper condition of the cell has been verified.
- For the sake of peaceful coexistence, we kindly ask guests who notice any dog without a tag or any breach of these rules to inform Reception.
- Management reserves the right to evict pet owners who cause nuisance to other guests or who do not respect these regulations. Likewise, we reserve the right to deny future accommodation requests.
